Greenest municipality nationally



At an awards ceremony held in Pretoria on Friday, 18 November 2011, Overstrand Municipality was proclaimed the first national winner in the local municipality category of the Greenest Municipality Competition. The announcement was made by the Deputy Minister of Water and Environmental Affairs, Ms Rejoice Madudafhasi. Johan van Taak, who coordinated Overstrand's entry in the competition, received the trophy, certificate and prize money cheque on behalf of the Municipality. The monetary award amounts to R 3.5 million, which can be accessed only with an approved business plan. The funds must be used to address issues of greening and also to advance the objectives of Expanded Public Works Program (EPWP) projects, which emphasise creation of temporary jobs and promotion of skills development. Projects to be included in the business plan should cover aspects of waste management, the management of open space systems or any aspect of environmental management.

GROENEWALD APPOINTED AS NEXT MUNICIPAL MANAGER

Mr Coenie Groenewald (56) has been appointed as the next Municipal Manager of Overstrand Municipality. On 1 January 2012 he will take over from the current incumbent, Adv Werner Zybrands, who will be retiring at the end of the year.

The resolution to appoint Mr Groenewald was accepted unanimously by the Council at the end of October following an extensive selection process involving an industrial psychologist. In total 41 applications were received and six candidates were invited for interviews and subjected to psychometric testing. The selection panel comprised councillors from both the Democratic Alliance and the ANC.

Mr Groenewald said he regards it as an absolute honour to work for Overstrand Municipality and that he is looking forward to assuming his new responsibilities since he knows he will have the support of a good and competent team

of municipal officials. He paid homage to his predecessors who placed the municipality on a sound footing.

Mr Groenewald grew up in Chrissiesmeer in Mpumalanga and matriculated at Hoërskool Ermelo in 1973. His career commenced in the public service but he has been working for local authorities since 1981. Studying part-time through the University of South Africa, he

obtained several degrees in related fields as well as a professional qualification through the former Institute of Town Clerks of Southern Africa.

Mr Groenewald has been with Overstrand Municipality in Hermanus since 2003 and currently holds the position of Director: Management Services.

He is married to Rita and they have three children.

MAN OR WOMAN, GET THE BREAST TEST

Not many staff members attended the breast cancer talk that was organized by Sister Heleen Mouton on Thursday, 6 October 2011. She had invited all the female Overstrand employees and only 35 attended.

Antoinette van Vuuren, a well-known physiotherapist, was the guest speaker. She recently attended training on breast cancer and had the latest information at her disposal.

She started her talk with a quick summary of bladder problems, since she specializes in treating these. Then she moved on to talk about breast cancer risk factors and danger signs to look out for, before demonstrating how to examine the breasts.

She pointed out that while men can also develop breast cancer it is 100 times more common in women than in men because of the female hormones estrogen and progesterone. Fat produces estrogen and increased levels of estrogen increase the chances of getting breast cancer. Women who are overweight tend to have higher blood insulin levels and these also have been linked to some cancers, including breast cancer.

A study that was done found that physical activity reduces the risk of breast cancer. The American Cancer Society recommends at least 45 - 60 minutes of exercise five times a week.

Antoinette ended off by holding a lucky draw. Prizes that were won were donated by Janeke of Hair dot com Hairdressing Salon, Lindi Prinsloo of Refine Beauty Salon, Lara de Kock of TLC Beauty Salon, Jonelle du Toit of Eve's Boutique while Ronel Meyer donated a gift pack from Avroy Shlain. Mayor Nicolette Botha-Guthrie, who also attended the talk, provided funds for refreshments.

The message from Sister is that everyone must get examined for breast cancer. Whether you are a man or a woman, it is important to know about your status at a very early stage.

Anyone who wishes to obtain more information about breast cancer or

wants to have a breast examination is welcome to contact me.

SUPPORT BAGS OF LOVE CAMPAIGN

At the launch of this year's Bags of Love Campaign Mayor Nicolette Botha-Guthrie called on employees to support this drive which is aimed at bringing joy and hope to the lives of the poorest of the poor by providing them with food parcels over Christmas.

The Bags of Love Campaign was started as a Christmas Appeal by the St Vincent de Paul Society of the Catholic Church six years ago and has developed since then into a community project with various other church denominations also taking part. According to organiser David Kershaw the aim is to fill 2 500 bags this year, but it will require a community effort. Last year 1 974 bags were filled, compared with the fewer than 100 bags that were filled at the start of the project.

This project entails obtaining a shopping bag from Eastcliff Spar and filling it with the following groceries (worth R89): 1 kg rice, 1 kg sugar, a pack of 26 tea bags, 400 gm peanut butter, 425 gm pilchards in tomato sauce, 200 gm soya mince (savory), 1 kg samp, 500 gm dried sugar beans, 1 kg mielie meal, 410 gm baked beans, 750 ml cooking oil and 500 gm salt.

Should any one be interested in sponsoring a bag, but cannot go out to select the groceries, the manager of Spar said that the bag will be filled on their behalf for the amount of R88.60.

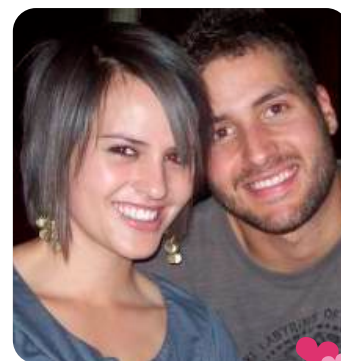

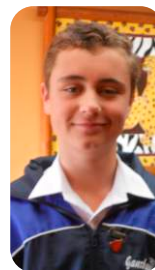
