Description of work

- (a) Floors and walls in and around toilets must be hosed clean on a daily basis.
- (b) Toilet bowls and washbasins must be cleaned (brushed).
- (c) Broken/defective toilets/wash basins must be reported daily to the help desk.
- (d) The Tenderer shall provide the cleaning materials i.e. disinfectants etc.
- (e) The Municipality will supply toilet paper.
- (f) The Tenderer must be available from 7am in the morning until 8 pm in the evening, 7 days a week. Besides cleaning the toilets, it will be expected of the Tenderer to supervise the handing out and collecting of toilet paper as residents make use of the facilities.
- (g) An area with a radius of 10 metres around the toilets to be kept clean. This includes the removal of plastic, bottles, paper and glass. This refuse to be collected into black bags and deposited at the nearest swing bins.

Please note:

Toilets will be inspected on a weekly basis. If it is not cleaned to the satisfaction of the inspector, a week's payment will be deducted. If this happens a second time the contract will be terminated.
