GRADUATION NIGHT FOR FINANCE OFFICERS

The hard work of a group of 23 colleagues was rewarded at a glittering graduation ceremony on Saturday 23 July in the Cape Town International Convention Centre, where almost 300 municipal officials from all over the Western Cape received their certificates in Local Government Accounting.

This certificate is required as an entry-level qualification for municipal financial officers in terms of National Treasury regulations. Funding for the training was made available through the Local Government SETA and the training started in April last year

with monthly three-day long sessions that continued until April this year.

The course dealt with aspects such as recording income and receipts, making and recording payments, working with computers, accounting work skills and professional ethics.

Assignments and exams had to be fitted in with the normal workload.

Further study opportunities in the financial field are available and we would encourage our colleagues to go for it.

OVERSTAND MUNICIPALITY RECEIVES INTERNATIONAL GIS AWARD

The Overstrand Municipality received a "Special Achievement in GIS" (SAG) award at the 2011 ESRI International Users Conference (IUC) in San Diego, California, USA. This award is given to user sites around the world to recognize outstanding work with Geographic Information System (GIS) technology. The IUC was attended by 15 000 delegates from 126 countries.

In presenting the award to the Overstrand Municipality, Mr Jack Dangermond, President of ESRI, said that "your organization

stood out from more than 100,000 others".

The project involved the development of GIS skills within the municipality, the capture and cleaning up of data, the design of databases, the development of procedures and programs, management of projects involving spatial data and the implementation of web deployed applications.

SEKURITEITSBEWUSTHEID NOODSAAKLIK

Diefstal, vermorsing, vandalisme en ander skade aan Raadseindom en -bates plaas 'n onnodige maar voorkombare las op die Raad se finansiële hulpbronne. Die voorkoms hiervan gee dikwels aanleiding tot onverhaalbare verliese en 'n verlagting in standarde van dienslewering, agteruitgang van die werkomgewing en 'n algemene gevoel van agterdogtigheid en onsekerheid onder beide werknemers en belastingbetaalers, sê mnr. Neville Michaels, Direkteur van Beskermingsdienste.

Hy meen dit is elke personeell se plig om individuele en gesamentlike eienaarskap van en verantwoordelikheid vir veiligheid en sekuriteit in beide hul areas van verantwoordelikheid en in die regssgebied van die Municipaaliteit Overstrand as 'n geheel te aanvaar. Dit sal ook 'n verandering in die fokus van veiligheid en sekuriteit vanaf 'n hoofsaklik reaktiewe na 'n voorkomende een te weeg bring.

Werknemers wat besorg is oor sekerheidsaspekte in hul omgewing moet dit onverwyld met hul bestuurders bespreek. Bestuurders kan te enige tyd die hoof van Wetstoepassing en Sekuriteitsdienste raadpleeg. Hy sal die nodige ondersteuning en advies bied om werk te maak van tekortkominge veral sover dit passiewe veiligheid, sekuriteit en beheerstelsels soos diefstoring, brandbestrydingstoerusting, alarmstelsels ens. betref.

Ten einde verliese weens sekuriteitsprobleme te verlaag en die gewenste veilige, beveiligde en aangename werkomgewing te skep, word almal ernstig gemaan om die volgende basiese maatreëls daagliks aan die hand van 'n kontrolelys te implementeer.

- Maak seker dat die werkplek ordelik en vry van rommel gehou word en dat vullis en afval gereeld na goedgekeurde areas verskuif word.
- Konfronteer alle vreemdelinge wat in 'n beperkte werkarea aangetref word en maak waar moontlik seker dat sulke areas afgesper word. Moet nooit vreemdelinge op hulle eie laat nie.
- Sorg dat waardevolle persoonlike besittings, sleutels, handsakke en dokumente te alle tye weggesluit is. Moenie die stelsel vertrou nie, voorkom eerder diefstal.
- Moet nooit kontant of waardevolle en vertroulike dokumente onder jou oë laat uitgaan nie of hulle onbewaak laat nie. Handig sulke dokumente net aan gemagtigde persone oor en hou verkiekslik ook 'n register. Waar moontlik, beperk dokumentasie wat by jou werkstasie gehou word tot die absolute minimum.
- Verseker dat branduitgange duidelik gemerk is en te alle tye vry van alle obstruksiës is. Maak seker dat branddeure toe bly veral nadat werk vir die dag afgehandel is.
- Verseker dat alle brandbestrydingstoerusting beskikbaar is, gemerk en binne bereik van die werkplek is en minstens een keer per jaar gediens word. Alle personeel moet vertroud wees met die gebruik van hierdie toerusting.
- Aan die einde van die werkdag, doen 'n formele veiligheidskontrole en verseker dat alle vensters en deure toe is, die tersaakklike alarmstelsels geaktiveer is en dat alle elektriese toebehore soos verwarmers, kantoorligte, ens. afgeskakel is.
- Neem kennis van persone wat later werk, veral buitekontrakteurs, en lig sekuriteit dienooreenkomsdig in.

According to Sister Heleen Mouton, Overstrand Municipality's occupational health nurse, in total 319 employees visited the events. The statistics were as follows:


- Gansbaai: 66 (21 medical aid & 45 non-medical aid)



Our well loved and friendly manager of Solid Waste management planning, Johan van Taak, was in for a gruelling time on Monday 18 July 2011 when the Greenest Town panel inspected our area for this year's Greenest Town Competition (GMC).

In the past this competition was for the Cleanest Town, but more categories were added and the emphasis is no longer only on waste management.

According to Johan the elements of the GMC and their respective weights are as follows:

- Waste Management - 45%;
- Energy Efficiency and Conservation - 15%;
- Tree planting and beautification - 15%;
- Water and Air Quality Management - 20%; and
- Leadership, Institutional Arrangements and Public participation - 5%.

"My role was to organize everything for the inspection. All the role players are pulled in with the Municipality so that the members of the panel can get all the information they desire," Johan told Phambili.

The Municipality received a questionnaire before the time and each department had to fill in the questions relevant to them.

The panelists spent the first hour or two asking questions and then went out with officials to do inspections.

Now Johan and the rest of us will have to wait till October, when the winners will be announced.
