GOOD NEWS REPORT

The 2009/2010 Annual Report of Overstrand Municipality as well as that of OLEDA were tabled by the Executive Mayor during the special council meeting of 26 January 2010 and the good news is that we received an unqualified audit report for the fourth consecutive year.

In her foreword Executive Mayor Nicolette Botha-Guthrie said it is an excellent report for a municipality that managed to show top performance and growth under difficult economic circumstances. She praised her predecessor, Mr Theo Beyleveldt, who was the mayor during the report period, for putting systems and mechanisms in place to monitor service delivery and budget implementation and to effect changes timeously.

An annual report is one of the most important guiding documents for any municipality in its quest to achieve its constitutional object of providing democratic and accountable governance to local communities.

Structured in a way to give easy access to important municipal information it is notable that one of the most detailed chapters are dealing with human resources and organisational management. In it one can find information about the TASK job grading, staff movements, performance management, training and skills development and employment equity.

At 30 June 2010 there were 1070 employees and the fixed establishment. For the year under review there were 50 terminations (5 percent of the staff complement) of which 14 discretionary resignations.

IMPLEMENTATION OF PMS

Management has decided to introduce a policy that is focused on motivating employees and recognising them for their hard work - this scheme is called a performance management system.

The Performance Management System (PMS) Implementation Policy and Rewards and Incentives Policy were approved by council in October 2008. The responsibility for the implementation of these policies resides with the Human Resources Department within the Management Services Directorate.

The Rewards and Recognition Committee (RRC) was constituted on 21 May 2010. The RRC mandate includes among

others to decide the best possible way for the roll-out of the Performance Management System. The RRC took due cognisance of the embedded risk of rolling out a system of this magnitude to the entire Municipality. It decided that the roll-out of the PMS would be done in two phases. Phase one included staff members on the old 'Van der Merwe' salary scales 0 to 6, while phase two included the remainder of the staff members.

To assist the Municipality in the roll-out and maintenance of the Performance Management System the Municipality procured the Ignite PMS system. Ignite provided training in the awareness of per-

formance management, development of Performance Plans and the evaluation of Performance Plans to phase one officials.

Staff members involved in phase one completed their Performance Plans electronically as well as submitting signed hardcopies to Human Resources for record keeping. These officials are currently busy with the first formal evaluation that was scheduled for completion by the end of January 2011.

Training for phase two employees is expected to commence during March 2011. The exact dates and venues for this training will be communicated to all affected staff members in due course.

With regard to the municipality's financial statements the report reveals that Overstrand had an income of R520 million in 2009/10, which is a great improvement of the R428 million received in 2008/9. Expenditure, however, also showed a sharp growth from R398 million in 2008/9 to R557 million in 2009/10. This can be ascribed to a sharp rise in the provision made for depreciation and amortisation from R34 million (2008/9) to R101 million (2009/10) as well as in the cost of bulk purchases (electricity). Due to this mainly paper entry the bottom line for Overstrand Municipality is a loss of R9 million.

ICT STRATEGY SESSION 2011

Research has indicated there is in general a need for a better understanding of ICT services and systems and the value it can add to enable cost effective service delivery.

In his opening statements the Director: Management Services, aptly referred to this first ever event in the Overstrand Municipality as “the power of the collective”.

The ICT strategy session was attended by 61 executive and senior officials with representations from all Directorates in the municipality. The business imperative of this session was further emphasized with the presence of the Executive Mayor, the Municipal Manager, two of our Councillors and the Directors.

The primary objectives of the strategy session were:


1. To establish a culture of mutual understanding between the ICT Division and the lines of business in the Overstrand Municipality on how ICT can add value to ensure cost effective and sustainable service delivery in the Overstrand Municipality;
2. To establish principles of co-management and effective communications between ICT, lines of business and external service providers in building ICT solutions that will enable cost effective and sustainable service delivery;
3. To identify specific challenges in our current ICT environment and what measures should be deployed to improve ICT services and systems in the Overstrand Municipality.

An ICT service delivery framework was proposed to establish a culture of effective governance and co-management that will enable the Overstrand Municipality to develop sustainable business systems that is cost effective and operationally efficient.

It was also emphasized that quality service delivery to all our communities and stakeholders are primarily dependant effective business processes with clearly defined roles and responsibilities. ICT systems are only enabling to assist with quality service delivery.

The concept of structure follows strategy was ex-

plained. Business processes and ICT systems form an integral part of cost effective service delivery. A best practice approach was proposed to ensure that future ICT projects will be delivered on time, within specifications and within budget.

Effective contract management also forms an integral part of the Service Delivery Agreements (SDA's) with service providers. Ongoing performance monitoring and events management will ensure compliance to management expectations and that the anticipated “value for money” is achieved.

The diversity of ICT business systems and architectures currently deployed in the Overstrand Municipality also create major challenges, from a technology as well as a management perspective. The concept of co-management to address these matters to find acceptable solutions were debated and agreed.

Jaap van Staden concluded that for the ICT Department, the bar has been raised once again. But at least now, for the first time, we are in partnership with our most valued client – the management and staff of the Overstrand Municipality.
