


CIDB CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION PROCESS

About the CIDB:

The Construction Industry Development Board (cidb) - a Schedule 3A public entity - was established by Act of Parliament ([Act 38 of 2000](#))  to promote a regulatory and developmental framework that builds:

- The construction delivery capability for South Africa's social and economic growth.
- A proudly South African construction industry that delivers to globally competitive standards.

The cidb's focus is on

- Sustainable growth, capacity development and empowerment
- Improved industry performance and best practice
- A transformed industry, underpinned by consistent and ethical procurement practices
- Enhanced value to clients and society

All construction work over a value of R 30 000 must be undertaken by a CIDB registered contractor. At present, the registration process for Grade 1's only takes 2 days, so there is no excuse for contractors not to be registered. In order to register you need:

- 1) Certified copies of your ID's
- 2) Copies of your company registration
- 3) Valid Tax Clearance Certificate
- 4) Completed application form (New short version for Grade 1)
- 5) Proof of payment of R 450.00 per category of Grading.
