

TENDER SC 753/2009 HIRE OF SEWERAGE VACUUM TANKERS

I. SPECIFICATIONS KLEINMOND

A.The vacuum tanker must -

- 1.have a capacity of at least 10 000l
- 2.be capable of removing domestic sewerage from conservancy/ septic tanks from properties in the towns of Kleinmond, Betty's Bay, Pringle Bay and Rooi Els.
3. be equipped with at least 6 lengths (+-4m long) of suction hoses (parrot male/female couplings)
- 4.be roadworthy, neat in appearance and OSHACT compliant.
- 5.be provided with a competent driver
- 6.be provided "wet" (self sufficient in respect of diesel/oils etc).

B.Hire period and working hours

- 1.The vacuum tanker must report daily for duty at 07h30 at the municipal yard in 13 th street, Kleinmond and work until 17h00.
- 2.**One** vacuum tanker is required for **15 December 2009 to 5 January 2010 (inclusive) - 22 days**
- 3.**TWO additional** vacuum tankers is required for the period **21 December 2009 to 4 January 2010 (inclusive) - 15x2 = 30 days**
- 4.The number of days required may vary due to fluctuating demand

C.General

1. The municipality will provide overnight parking facilities at the tenderers own risk, for the vehicle in the municipal yard, if required
2. The municipality will provide 2 assistants and radio communication to each tanker
3. The driver of the tanker must complete and hand in the list of tanks pumped on a daily basis
4. The service provider must allow in the quoted rate for the travelling costs to and from Kleinmond.
5. The service provider must provide for all the above in the **rate/day** quoted, **including VAT**, and insert the rate in form **MBD 1**.
6. Should the successful tenderer be required to work after normal hours (over time) the tenderer must provide for all the above in the **rate/hour** tendered, including VAT, and insert the rate in form **MBD 1**.

II. SPECIFICATIONS GANSBAAI

A.The vacuum tanker must -

- 1.have a capacity of at least 10 000l
- 2.be capable of removing domestic sewerage from conservancy/ septic tanks from properties in the area of Gansbaai. (de Kelders to Buffeljags)
3. be equipped with at least 6 lengths (+-4m long) or one 8m & one 12m of suction hoses (parrot male/female couplings)
- 4.be roadworthy, neat in appearance and OSHACT compliant.
- 5.be provided with a competent driver
- 6.be provided "wet" (self sufficient in respect of diesel/oils etc).

B.Hire period and working hours

- 1.The vacuum tanker must report daily for duty at 07h30 at the municipal yard in Gansbaai and work until 17h00.
- 2.**One** vacuum tanker is required for **15 December 2009 to 5 January 2010 (inclusive) - 22 days**
- 3.**ONE additional** vacuum tankers is required for the period **24 December to 4 January 2010 (inclusive) = 12 days**
- 4.The number of days required may vary due to fluctuating demand

C.General

1. The municipality will provide overnight parking facilities at the tenderers own risk, for the vehicle in the municipal yard, if required
2. The municipality will provide 2 assistants and radio communication to each tanker
3. The driver of the tanker must complete and hand in the list of tanks pumped on a daily basis
4. The service provider must allow in the quoted rate for the travelling costs to and from Gansbaai.
5. The service provider must provide for all the above in the **rate/day** tendered, **including VAT**, and insert the rate in form **MBD 1**.
6. Should the successful tenderer be required to work after normal hours (over time) the tenderer must provide for all the above in the **rate/hour** tendered, including VAT, and insert the rate in form **MBD 1**.
