# 74. PAYDAY: AMENDMENT TO POLICY

## **Department : Town Secretary**

At present Council's policy regarding payday reads as follows :

"Payday is on the 25<sup>th</sup> of each month, or on the first work day thereafter should the 25<sup>th</sup> day of the month fall on a week-end or PUBLIC HOLIDAY. However, the month of December in every year would be the exception, in which case payday would be the last normal workday before the 25<sup>th</sup> (Christmas Day)."

### RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2. However, the month of December in every year would be the exception, in which case payday would be the last normal working day before the 25th (This year payday will be 22 December 2000).
